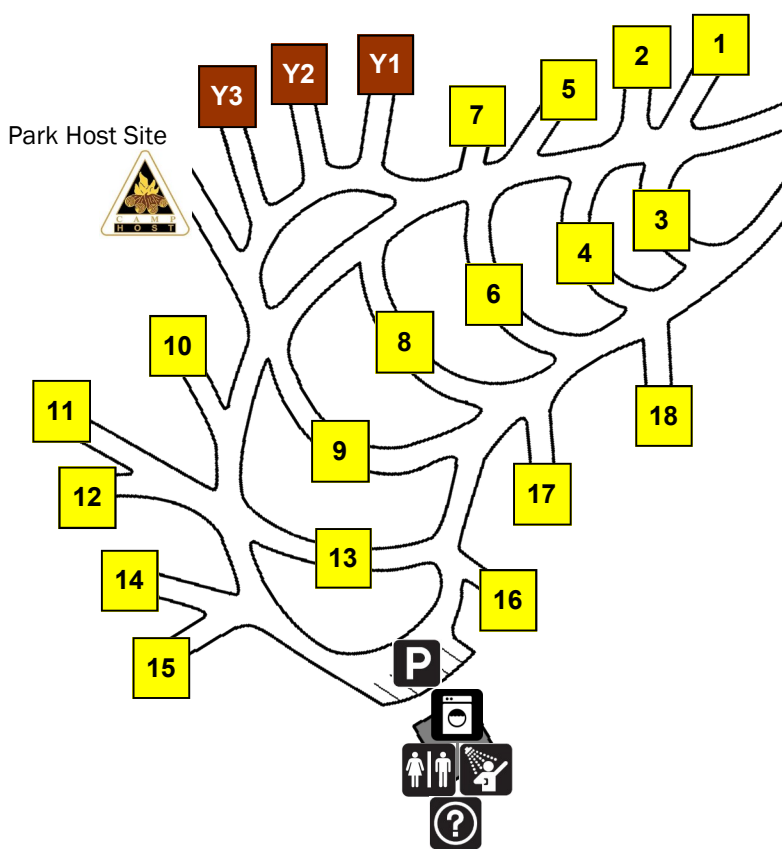


# Chippokes State Park

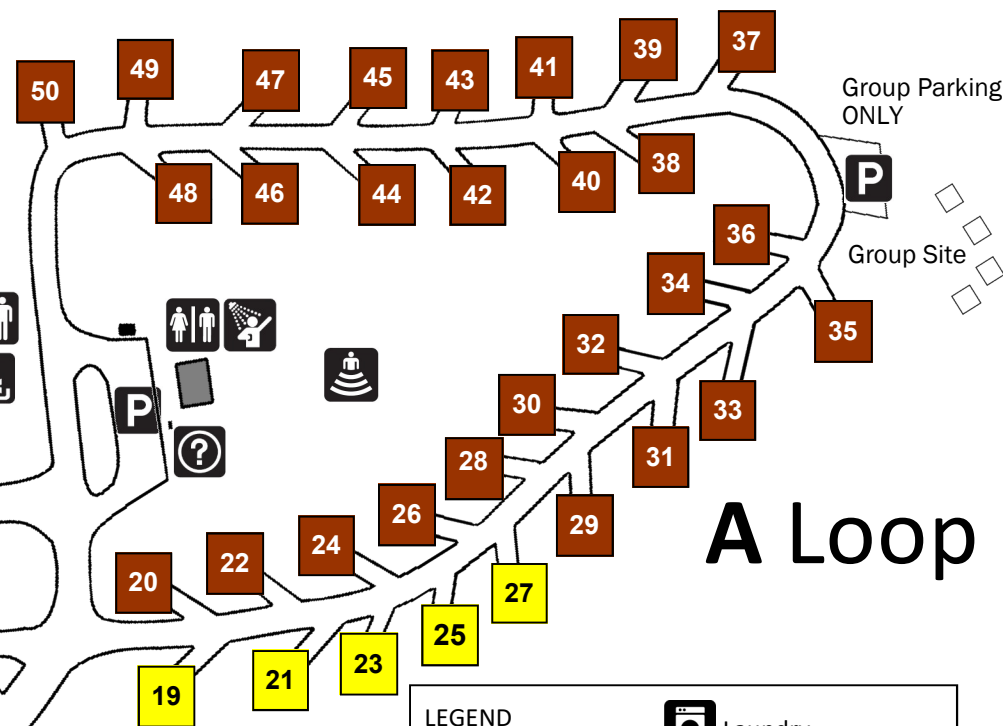
## Finding Your Site:

The Campground consists of two “loops”, A and B. Your reservation will indicate which loop you are in as well as the number of the site, e.g. A33, B7, etc. Site posts in the campground show ONLY the number of the site and NOT which loop you are in. Fortunately, the campground is numbered 1-50, and there are no repeating numbers. Yurts are located in the B Loop and are numbered Y1-Y3.

## Camping Without A Reservation:

ALL sites in the campground are site-specific. Walk-in campers may ONLY set up for 1 night of camping and you must ensure the site is not currently occupied, or due to be occupied. Check the site post for a tag AND verify availability with the Camp Host or Park Host. Walk-in reservations may ONLY be done after 4 PM—No Exceptions. You MUST check at the office the next morning if you wish to extend your stay. We can not guarantee you will be able to stay in the site in which you initially set up.

## Campground Regulations

The following guidelines are established to ensure your safe and enjoyable camping experience, and to protect this valuable resource:

- You must be at least **18 years of age**, photo ID required, to rent a campsite.
- The individual renting the campsite is the **responsible party**; ensure your guests are following all regulations.
- Campsite fees entitle campers to the use of one campsite for a maximum of six (6) people and two (2) vehicles.
- All camping equipment and vehicles must be placed on the campsite. Parking on the grass or over landscape timbers is **prohibited**. Additional vehicles **MUST** be parked in the overflow or pool parking lot; Guests visiting for the day **MUST** pay park entry fees AND park in the overflow lots.
- Check-in time is 4:00 pm. Check-out time is 1:00 pm.
- **PUBLIC USE OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES IS PROHIBITED.**
- All pets must be controlled and restrained at ALL times. Please clean up pet waste and dispose of in proper containers. (see publication *Pets in Parks Guide* for more information.)
- **QUIET HOURS START AT 10 PM AND CONTINUE TO 6 AM. USE OF RADIOS AND OTHER DISRUPTIVE ACTIVITIES ARE PROHIBITED DURING THIS TIME.**
- Park regulations prohibit the destruction, vandalism, or removal of structure, facilities, plants or trees.

## Regulation Continued...

- Properly dispose of all trash. Dumpsters are located at the exit points on both sides of the campground.
- Fires are permitted in fire rings **ONLY**, and must be attended at all times. Firewood is for sale, \$7 per bundle, located across from Bathhouse A. Please extinguish all fires before departure. From February 15—April 30, fires are **ONLY** permitted IF a park host or camp host are on duty.
- Generator use is not allowed in the campground.
